

It's time to Tune-Up your Playset!

Here's how to do it!

Materials needed: Redwood stain (we carry the best redwood stain, so come buy it from us!), a 2 1/2 inch brush, a staining mitten, and a pressure washer (2000psi or less) with a wide fan nozzle.

- 1) Remove the tarp (if applicable), slide and swings.
- 2) Pressure wash the entire set, top to bottom, inside and out at about 6 feet away (so as to not damage the wood).
- 3) Let the set dry completely (time will depend on sunlight and warmth of the day).
- 4) While the playset is drying, tighten all the hardware on the playset with a 9/16" socket wrench (don't forget the top of the swing beam!). Then do a safety check of the playset.
- 5) Sand down any areas that need a bit of attention (if applicable)
- 6) Using your staining mitten, stain the playset from top to bottom and inside and out. Do not use a sprayer; it splatters and causes drip marks. Use the brush in between the slats of the playset.
- 7) This whole process varies depending on your playset, but allow 4 to 6 hours for the whole process.
